

WEIGHTS AND DIMENSIONS

For every service that DHL Express offers, there are specific weight and dimensional limits that apply globally. The tables below help you navigate and compare these standards. Note that not all services listed are available in all countries.

^{*1} A fixed surcharge for an Oversize Piece applies to packages or pallets with a single length exceeding 100 cm, unless an Overweight Piece surcharge already applies to the same package or pallet. Pieces with a single base length up to 300cm are accepted.

Packages over 70 kg must be securely placed on a pallet and be stackable. DHL Express does not accept shipments exceeding 3,000kg, or containing pieces exceeding 1,000kg or 300cm in length. All shipments and pieces must meet DHL packing standards: please refer to our packaging guide at mydhl.express.dhl

Additional handling surcharges apply to packages and pallets that require special processing, such as manual handling or when automatic sorting is not possible. Please refer to the <u>DHL Servicegids</u> for a complete overview of all surcharges and their application.

^{*2} A surcharge for a Non-Conveyable Piece applies to packages or pallets weighing between 25 kg and 70 kg, unless the Overweight Piece or Oversize Piece surcharge applies. For packages or pallets exceeding 70 kg (actual or volumetric weight), an Overweight Piece surcharge always applies.
